<b>To improve student achievement in reading</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Continue Reading First model in K-3.</li> <li>▪ Identify ways to continue Reading First beyond grant funded years: development of data leaders K-5, form an intervention team, and Building Leadership team.</li> <li>▪ Continued utilization of the Data Teams model in 4<sup>th</sup> &amp; 5<sup>th</sup> grade.</li> <li>▪ Using full time specials teachers to support teachers in regular and bilingual classes.</li> <li>▪ Utilization of Title 1 resources: after school program for 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade, small group instruction for K-5 students during the day. This process allows for two layers of support to be offered to each grade level in order to support struggling students.</li> <li>▪ Utilization of the enrichment group in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade in order to work with excelling students in reading.</li> </ul>
