October Meeting Recap

New Badges, etc.:

Chrissy Poppen distributed new District 129 ID badges to all SCAC Representatives. In addition, she also handed out copies of the science feedback from the September meeting. Dr. Rydland had updated Building Audits to distribute, as well.

Registration Update:

Chrissy updated the SCAC Representatives on the progress that has been made in regards to examining the district's registration processes. She circulated the matrix that was developed to show information from neighboring districts. The Reps were then informed about the groups that have met to discuss registration "best practices" and to address possible improvements. Some open discussion followed. Chrissy will follow-up by sending copies of the matrix to the Reps via e-mail. The SCAC Representatives were encouraged to share any additional thoughts on processes and forms.

Survey Discussion:

The SCAC Representatives broke into several groups and began discussion of surveys and their potential use throughout the district. They were asked to consider who the surveys would be given to, when they would be given, how the survey would be administered, and what content areas the survey should address. Dr. Rydland then asked for input and feedback from the Reps for each school level (elementary through high school). The feedback sheets were collected. The summary will be shared with all Representatives.

Discipline Presentation:

Dr. Rydland distributed copies of the Student Code of Conduct and Rights and Responsibilities. Much discussion ensued about discipline throughout the district and what Dr. Rydland's expectations are at each school. He asked each Rep to read through each document so that feedback could be shared. In addition, he asked SCAC to think about additional subjects that could be discussed as they pertain to discipline: school safety, PBIS, discipline at bus stops and on buses, bullying, etc.
